PRIORITY ITEMS NEEDED

The National Conference of Black Mayors and the World Conference of Mayors have begun to mobilize and galvanize their respective networks of Member Mayors, Business Council Members, corporate partners and national partners to assist in the strategic coordination of relief efforts to the people of Haiti. NCBM recommends that where possible, each Member Mayor place a storage container within city hall to collect donated relief items from their respective citizens.

Blankets

Additional Items That May Be Donated

First Aid Items (band-aids, cotton ball, alcohol, painkillers, gauze, antiseptic, etc.)
Personal Hygiene Items (toothbrushes, toothpaste, deodorant, sanitary napkins, etc.)
Towels
Sheets
